ILR functionality is fully integrated with the UNIT-e Student Record Tracking System including Fee and Examination modules. UNIT-e provides a number of features that aid rapid and error-free ILR production. In addition statistical modules enable funding and target information to be maintained and monitored.

- UNIT-e supports all ILR formats including FE, Work Based Learning (WBL) and Adult & Community Learning (ACL) Returns
- UNIT-e provides validation routines both during individual student enrolment and as a batch process
- UNIT-e provides flexible data entry screens (Information Interfaces) enabling colleges to define data capture layouts
- UNIT-e provides facilities to update data rapidly including grid-edit tools which enable fast error correction

Target Setting and Tracking through UNIT-e Business Manager enables colleges to review potential funding income for new or revised course offerings and set student number targets from enquiry and applications through enrolment to completion and achievement. Funding Data Information Access - Executive Analysis Suite provides the facility to import Funding data from the LSC's funding calculator (LIS Suite) which is then combined with Student Records and present information via a web-based browsing facility, enabling all staff to monitor funding incomes
