



UNIT-e Student Record & Tracking Solution (SRTS) Extended Applications

UNIT-e SRTS Extended Applications enables you to enter and process all your applicants and their applications and to monitor their progress throughout the admissions cycle by means of an audit trail. This includes those from agents such as UCAS. At the end of the admissions cycle you will be able to identify all successful applicants accepted by your institution and simply transfer the admissions records to create enrolments.

You can also access the Extended Applications software to gain statistical information concerning the current status of applications for a particular course, part of a course, or to the institution as a whole.

You can create and maintain a Standard Offer Library in Extended Applications that can be applied or edited on an individual or block basis, making decision processing simple and efficient.

Standard Letters

You can create and generate individual or block letters using MS Word standard letter facility and database reports. Extended Applications interfaces with UCAS-Link and MARVIN and uses the agent's reference data as well as offering flexible user interface to create unique lookups and reports.

Application Events

By creating application events you can arrange interviews, make decisions and generate letters.

Interviews

You can create timed individual or group interviews with linked scheduled activities for events such as joint interview/open days.
